 - Brochure on Environmental Awareness

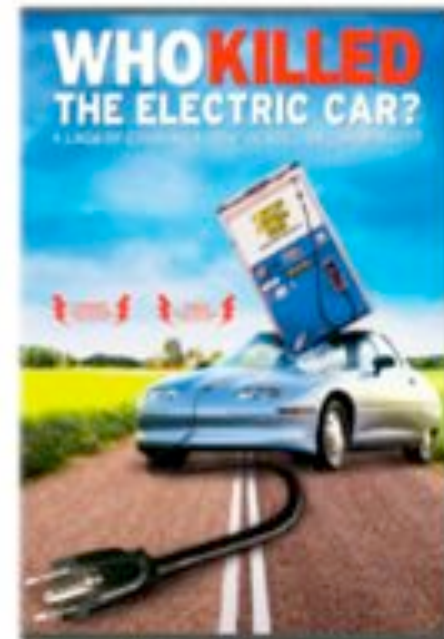

Conserve Electricity


Did you know?
